ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14(1)

Notice of Temporary Traffic Order
Bicester-Howes Lane
Prohibition of Through Traffic
Date of Order: 6 January 2020
Coming into force: 13 January 2020

This Order is being introduced because of sewer works associated with a new development which are anticipated to be completed on 24 January 2020.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily prohibit any vehicle proceeding in that part of Howes Lane north of Middleton Stoney Road.

Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed to indicate when the measures are in force.

Exemptions are included for police, fire and ambulance services and for the works and for access to premises which are only accessible from the closed section of road.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the closure is via A4095-Skimmingdish Lane-A4421-Charbridge Lane-Wretchwick Way-A41-Vendee Drive and vice versa

This Order will remain in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
